### Hello, dear brothers in Jesus and beloved Church:

We greet you with love and affection in the name of Jesus Christ.

We would like to share with you the greatness of our God through his work worldwide, especially here in South Korea.

Brothers, I would like to encourage you to continue trusting in the Lord and to continue supporting the missionary work. Without a doubt, the Lord Jesus is glorified in all the places where the gospel is being preached.

In December the Lord allowed us to have a good Christmas and year-end service, where we could see how the Lord confirmed the hearts of the brothers who are attending Betesda Baptist Church.

At Christmas dinner God provided us with a turkey! Maybe for many of you it doesn't cause much impact, but in South Korea it costs 70-80usd each and God provided it for us in only 12usd! at Costco! For some of the brothers, it was the first time they had tasted turkey in their lives and, according to what they said, they liked it a lot. Glory to God for this beautiful gift! I preached about the great salvation of our Lord Jesus Christ, and we had a very good response to the message.

We also celebrated my daughter Emma's birthday and one of the ladies who attend our church brought a visitor to the party and glory to God that I was able to preach the gospel of Jesus to her. She grew up in a very legalistic Korean church and has a lot of resentment towards God. So, we ask for your prayers for her so that her heart can be healed, and she returns to the ways of the Lord Jesus. Her English name is Kris.

Our church celebrated the end and the beginning of a new year on January 1, 2023, but in Korea the new year was celebrated on January 19, 2023, because they use the lunar calendar. So, we had two New Year's celebrations in the same year.

Usually on Lunar New Year day is no worship service in churches as it is an event that brings the family together, however brother Chong Min ( 정민 ) came to the prayer service on Thursday and brought us typical end-of-year gifts. Here the day of the end of the year is called SOL-LAR ( 설날 ).

In January we had our regular services. We had first time visitors and God allowed us to have the special day on January 26th. That day we planned a game night, and I was able to invite Pastor Kowach who brought the word of God, special songs and we had a good time sharing in a Christian environment. The brothers certainly enjoyed this time so far and build a new relationship between us.

During December and January, we distributed 560 invitations to our church, in addition to those that we placed in the mailboxes of the houses. I am moving all our advertising digitally through social networks and we continue to pray to have a website. But for the moment we only advertise the church through social networks.
